Peter Ciuha continues studies of Video and New Media at the Academy of Fine Arts and Design in Ljubljana in the field of visualisation of music.

The computer part of the project is being developed at the Faculty of Computer and Information Science; the author of the software is Bojan Klemenc, computer engineer.

He is the author and co-author of fine art textbooks for 7th, 8th and 9th grade of primary school, published by Založba Mladinska knjiga publishing house. He is currently preparing guidelines for teachers. Father of 14-year-old son Jakob, future archaeologist. More.
